
Bird ID Guide

Join us as we look for some common shore birds or search your neighborhood and document what birds you can find!





Snowy egret (wetlands and some beaches)

Key Features: White body, long black beak, black legs, and vellow feet.



Great blue heron (wetlands)

Key Features: Grayish blue bodies, black stripe over eye, long grey beak, and long grey legs.



Ruddy duck (wetlands)

Key Features: Small duck with short black beak (blue if breeding season), black and white head, rust colored body, and a black upright tail.



Black necked stilt (wetlands)

Key Features: Black on top of body, head and wings,, white on lower body and head, medium length black beak, and pink long legs.



Brown pelican (ocean)

Key Features: Grayish brown body, white-ish neck, yellow head, and a huge brownish orange beak. Beak also has a stretchy pouch that connects to the neck.



Heermann's gull (ocean)

Key Features: Dark gray wings, gray wings, white heads, and a bright orangey red beak with a black tip.
