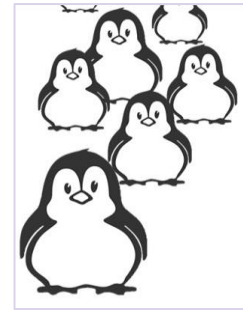


Sea Otter Craft

Materials:

- paper bag (or rectangular piece of paper)
- crayons/colored pencils/markers
- glue or tape
- sheet of paper (scratch /recycle paper works!)
- scissors



Step 1. Draw and cut out (2) arms, (2) hind flippers, (1) tail, (2) ears.

Step 2. Position your bag so that the opening of the bag is closest to you and the flap is faced up, just like in the picture. This will be your sea otter body.

If you're using a piece of paper, have the rectangle with the short sides on the top and bottom.

Step 3. Draw and color eyes and nose on top flap or towards the top of the rectangle. If you have spare paper, you can cut out eyes and glue or tape them on.

Optional: open up the flap and draw a mouth inside!



Step 4. Glue ears to the top corners. Glue on the arms and hind flippers, and attach the tail sticking out from the back. This will look like your otter is laying on its back, eating on its belly!

Decorate as you like. you can even draw and cut out a tasty snack for your otter to hold! Enjoy!

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
