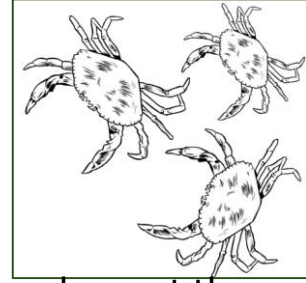


# You Be The Explorer!

## Exploring at home:

Go to the Science on a Sphere website: [sos.noaa.gov](http://sos.noaa.gov)

Access a range of data sets using the 'data set' tab in the upper right corner. Lets see what you can discover.

Try this first:

Use the 'Hurricane Season 2017' map to watch for these massive storms.

- How do you know when a storm has become a hurricane?
- How many hurricanes can you count?

Next, take some time to explore other data sets.

- Which data sets are your favorite?
- Which data sets seem the most surprising to you?
